5. Language	5	The project includes more than one ICOM official language, or non-official languages.
6. Budget	25	The budget is detailed, consistent, coherent and well presented.
7. Innovativeness	5	The project is creative, original and offers new ideas and solutions for museum practice.
8. Sustainability	10	The project makes a careful use of resources and assesses its expected long-term impact. It fosters the involvement of the communities, establishes or reinforces long-term partnerships and is environment-friendly. Ideally, the project relates to at least one of 17 Sustainable Development Goals.
